#### **Drawn Football Finals**

In the event of a draw, the following will apply;

- a. The teams will change ends following a break of no more than three minutes.
- b. A five minute quarter will be played before immediately changing ends for another five minute quarter.
   There is to be no break between these quarters.
- c. If at the end of the second five minute quarter, the scores are still level, no change of ends will occur, play will be restarted at the centre bounce and the first score will win.

#### **Drawn Netball Finals**

- (i) There is a four (4) minute time allowance to enable teams to change ends and scores will be verified on the official scoresheet
- (ii) Positional changes and substitutions may be made during changeover time.
- (iii) 2 x 5 minute halves will be played for all matches
- (iv) At the end of the first half teams there is an interval of (1) minute in which teams shall change ends
- (v) Substitutions and positional changes may be made during both these intervals
- (vi) Should there still be a draw at the end of the second half of extra time. Play continues until one team has a twogoal advantage
