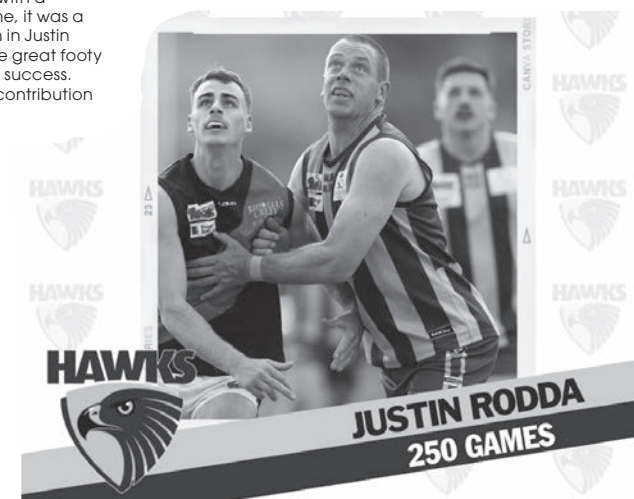
History created as the club achieves its best finals series to date with more to come!

This weekend as teams take part in preliminary finals please remember these are just games.

Be respectful and be kind to each other. Your teammates, your opposition, umpires and spectators.

Community sport is supposed to be a fun safe place for everyone.

Where you form a community who have your back and will support you through the good times and the bad and everything in between.

Most days across the finals series I have found myself having conversations where I am asking supporters to be passionate be loud but be fair and show respect and good sportsmanship.

Let's make this a weekend where I don't have to.

Personally, I would like to send my heartfelt condolences to Kel, Tim, Sarah, Amy and all their friends and family.

There are no words to explain the heartache they must be feeling.

They are a beautiful family who epitomise what community sport is all about.

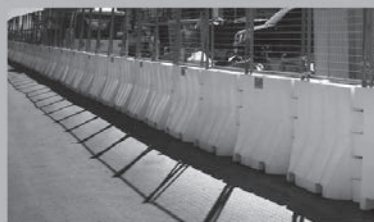

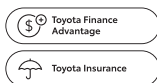
