Diggers Rest vs Wallan

What a showdown this will be. Both teams will play finals and both teams still missing a few key players. From the Coaches:

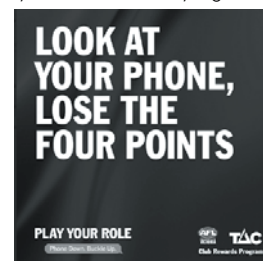

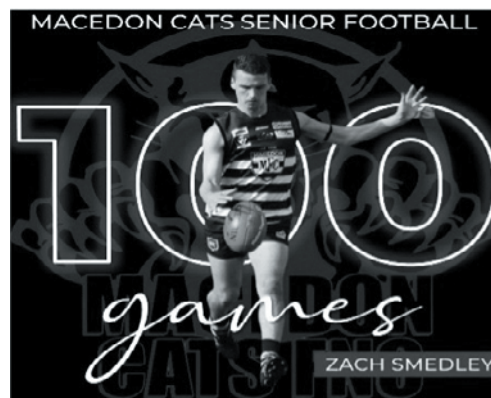

a true gentleman both on and off the field, we are extremely grateful for all his years of service to Macedon.

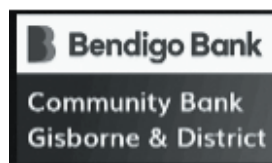

Leaders do not blame anyone else if they are wrong. A good sports leader is able to confess his mistakes and apologize.


9. They are continually seeking to improve

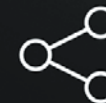

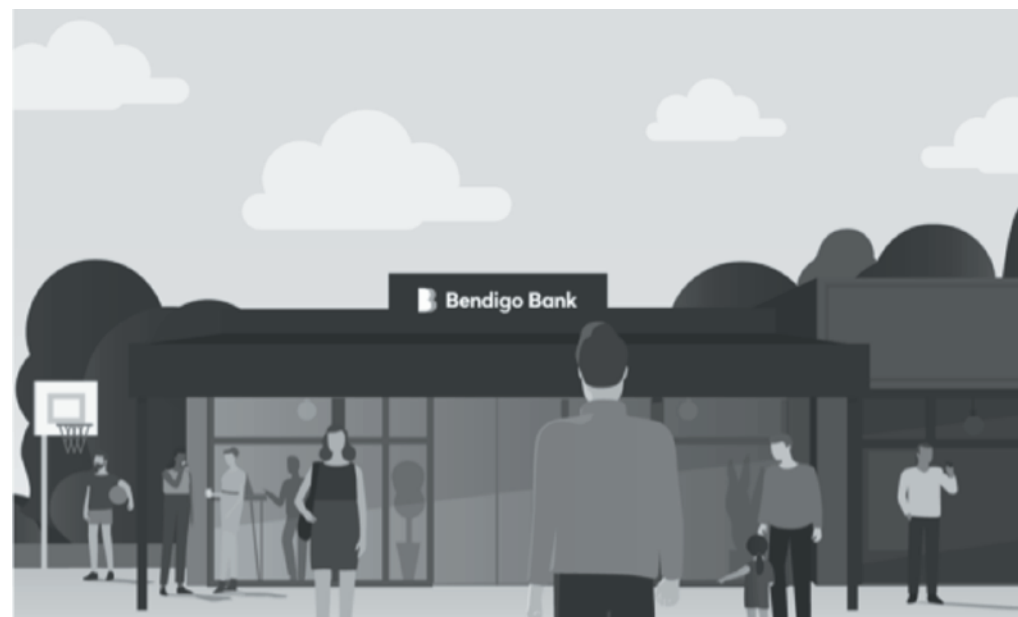
