Riddell versus Western Rams

TACKLE YOUR FEELINGS



Essendon are partnering with the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) program to make mental health training available to community coaches, in 2023. Tackle Your Feelings is a free mental health training program for community AFL coaches, as well as committee members and other club support staff. The program is delivered by a local psychologist and aims to help participants gain the tools to Understand, Recognise and Respond to signs of mental ill-health in their players. In 2021, the program was delivered to more than 4000 community coaches from 352 clubs across every Australian state and territory. 'Tackle your Feelings' was inspired by mental health education developed for AFL professional coaches and players, consisting of a face-toface presentation from a local psychologist and additional online learning. Ambassadors include Leon Cameron, Alastair Clarkson, Nathan Buckley, Neville Jetta, Kara Antonio and Dylan Buckley also feature throughout


the video content within the program. The program was formed by the AFL Coaches Association, AFL Players' Association and Zurich Insurance in 2018, after the tragic death of Adelaide coach Phil Walsh three years

Once coaches complete the training (workshop and online modules) they will have access to resources including blogs, podcasts and videos to assist with their ongoing learning. Club Notes

MFNC welcomes you to Tony Clarke Reserve and invites you to take part in our 2023 Anzac Day Service, to remember all those who served their country in all wars. Anzac Day was officially named in 1916; 12 months after the Australian & New Zealand Armed Forces formed the Allied Expedition. They set out to capture the Gallipoli Peninsular; they became known as ANZAC's. The pride they took in this name continues to this day.

This is one of the biggest days of our season and we welcome you all to the club. A short service will be held at 1.30pm prior to the commencement of the senior game to pay tribute and remember those who have served in all wars. At the conclusion of the senior football and netball games the Grumont Medal & McDougall Medal will be presented to the Most Courageous player.

Grumont Medal & McDougall Medals are named in honour of two of our local families who valiantly served our country.

Henry Grumont married Miss Mary McIntosh; they resided in Upper Macedon and raised 10 children. **Arthur Laughlin Grumont** was the first of their sons to enlist on 14th April 1914; he joined the 9th Battalion, H Division. He later became 2nd Lieutenant of 49th Battalion. On Arthur's return to Australia, he was awarded the 1914-15 Stars, The British Medal & the Medal of Victory for his service in 1918. The first tree in Honour Avenue was planted in his name, commemorating the first to enlist from Macedon.

Colin David Grumont enlisted on 7th June 1915 as a Sapper. He died from wounds inflicted in France 18th June 1918 aged 21. He is buried at Somme. **James Lindsay Grumont** aged 22, enlisted on the same day as his brother Colin.

He returned home in January 1918 after being badly gassed. The fourth son to enlist was **Albert Charles**, who at the age of 29, joined up on 12th July 1915. He achieved the rank of Sergeant, in July 1918; he was shot and killed between lines at Fromelles. Albert was awarded the 1914-15 Star, The British Medal, and the Victory Medal.

Mc Dougall Medal

Catherine (Kitty) Agnes McDougall 1889-1976

On April 25th, 1917, Catherine enlisted as a Staff Nurse and embarked from Melbourne on the 'Karoola' on that day, her war records show she served in the Australian Army Nursing Service and returned to Australia on February 6th, 1919. After her return from the war, Catherine joined the Good Shepherd Order of Nuns and died in Fitzroy in 1976 aged 87 years. Trees in Honour Avenue, Macedon recognise the contribution of Catherine & her sister Mary for their service to our country.

Mary Isabella McDougall 1885-1974

On July 25th, 1917, Mary enlisted as a Staff Nurse and embarked from Melbourne on the 'Somali'. After her return Mary also joined the Good Shepherd Order of Nuns but left and for a time became Matron of Xavier College. Mary became active in the district as an Infant Welfare Nurse in 1952, operating from the CWA Hall at Mt Macedon. Mary died in 1974 at the age of 89 a Nazareth House and is buried in the family grave at Macedon cemetery.

After just one round of junior and senior netball the behaviour is once again an issue in the RDFNL.

Many club coordinators have had issues with parents, while umpires continue to have issues with players, coaches and spectators.

Use this as a friendly reminder that this is community sport and everyone should feel safe and hve fun playing a sport we all love.

There's no denying that spectators are essential to sports. Without the active participation of spectators and parents, clubs would struggle to find players, coaches, administrators, and umpires

So if you witness any poor behaviour we ask you to call it out.

Poor parent sideline behaviour may include:

Foul language, threats or aggression directed toward the coach, umpire, player or even another parent.

Providing excessive instruction, or coaching from the sidelines. Often, in contrast to what the coach has instructed, generating confusion and embarrassment for players.

Put downs of a player's abilities, in private, or in front of others

Parents demonstrating poor sportsmanship

When parents behave poorly at sporting matches, children are more likely to drop out of team sports. Furthermore, if you emphasise a 'winning is everything' attitude, you make the sport less fun, and more stressful for the child. Children are taught that mistakes are not okay, and give up on trying for the fear of the consequences. Also, it's important for us to remember, and to remind our kids that mistakes are natural, and only make better players. Junior sports should be about socialising, keeping active and developing skills, but most importantly: having fun.

Blaming the umpire

When people blame an umpire for the result of a game, children learn to make excuses for outcomes. During a single match, thousands of decisions are made by umpires, coaches and players. So, to focus on one single decision made by an umpire, as the sole reason for the outcome of the game only teaches children how to absolve themselves of responsibility for their own actions. This leads to children who are less resilient, and who give up when facing adversity, for they feel they have no control over outcomes. Also, criticising the umpires sets an extremely bad example for children. Observing adults abusing an umpire teaches children that, they too may act disrespectfully towards authority figures. Once children learn a behaviour like this, it's common for the rude behaviour to carry over into other areas of their lives, including school, family, and even work later in life. It's also important to remember that umpires are often minors themselves, and only making calls they believe to be the fairest. They don't deserve the verbal abuse they are often at the receiving end of. If you have constructive

criticism to offer, wait until the end of the game, and speak with your coordinator.

What should I do if I see another parent acting poorly on the sidelines?

It can be quite intimidating to witness another parent acting aggressively on the sidelines, and it's for this reason that you can't sit idly by. Also, if the behaviour makes you feel uncomfortable, imagine how frightening it is for your child and their teammates. Bring it up to the coordinator and stress how important addressing this behaviour is to you. Ultimately, they are responsible for the behaviour of their team's parent spectators and can impose penalties onto the child or the parent. Many clubs have policies to deal with abusive parents which may result in them being suspended or even banned from attending matches. You should not turn a blind eye to this problematic behaviour that is creeping into the RDFNL. Remind other parents of the club's code of conduct, and the consequences of breaching this code. Often, if you privately call a parent out on their poor behaviour, you can curb it before it gets out of hand. Discourage toxic behaviours by making positive comments from the sidelines, and reminding other parents to focus on a child's strengths, and not their weaknesses. Try not to engage in complaining about coaches with other spectators. Often tempting, it can be a difficult habit to break, once started. If you feel you have legitimate concerns, arrange an appointment with the coach to discuss. Remember that coaches want the best for their teams, and should be receptive to easing your worries. Also, you should be respectful and positive towards the parents of the other team, and refrain from making negative comments about their players. When your child sees their parents exhibiting good sportsmanship, they are more likely to display it, too.

What is good sideline behaviour?

Many clubs have a code of conduct which specifies their expectations from parents and spectators during a match. It may be similar to the following recommendations:

Before and after each game remind your child that you're proud of them. No matter how they play.

Show support and encouragement to all players on the field.

Let the coach "coach", while you simply spectate and enjoy the game

Honour the decision of the umpire. They make the call they believe to be the fairest.

Don't let the heat of the moment get to you. Ask yourself if your behaviour will embarrass your child, or yourself later.

Thank the coaches and referees for their commitment and effort. Most junior sports officials cite abuse from parents as the most stressful component of the job, which can lead them to quit.

Prioritise fun. Have fun yourself, and make sure your child enjoys the game too.

Prediction: Macedon to win comfortably.




