POSITION/TASK PROFILE	 To lead and develop a Coaching Staff that includes RDFNL or external coaches who will act as the Assistant Coaches, to implement the RDFNL Junior Interleague Policy to develop junior players in the program. Recruit a Team Manager, Runner and (where known) a Sports Trainer. Liaise with the RDFNL Club Development Manager in delivery of the training program and games. Actively lead the selection process of the team in conjunction with RDFNL JDO in line with the RDFNL Selection Policy and keeping in mind the spirit to involve all RDFNL clubs. Communication of weekly training activities and squad changes to all stakeholders. Organisation and operation of training sessions. Promote a safe and enjoyable playing environment where players can increase their skill capability and knowledge of the game. Provide assistance and feedback on the development and skill enhancement of players on an individual basis. Provide a feedback report to the RDFNL Club Development Manager after the conclusion of the program
