Concussion Guidelines

The AFL has introduced new Concussion Guidelines for community football to further align with the Concussion Policy at the elite level. The AFL is taking concussion extremely seriously and we encourage all Clubs and relevant Club trainers to access the Guidelines and implement them at Club level to ensure any player who suffers a concussion is cared for appropriately and does not return to training or matches until it is safe to do so.

AFL Victoria Strategic Community Investment Fund

Round 2 applications for the AFL Victoria Strategic Community Investment Fund (SCIF) for 2021 are now open. The SCIF will provide grant funding of \$1.5 million per year for the next three years directly to local football Leagues and Clubs. The fund is part of the \$18 million investment into Victorian Community Football announced by the AFL in September 2019, the largest investment in community football in the state in more than two decades.








2021 NEW LAWS OF THE GAME

17.3 PROTECTED AREA

Other than the Player bringing the football into play, all Players must make every endeavour to immediately vacate the Protected Area described in Diagram 3.



17.4 ATTACKING TEAM DELAYING RECOMMENCEMENT OF PLAY

Where the field Umpire is of the opinion that a Player from the Attacking Team:

- is within the Protected Area described in Law 17.3 at the time when a Player from the Defending Team is bringing the football back into play, and not made every endeavour to immediately vacate the area;
- has prevented or attempted to prevent the Player from the Defending Team from bringing the football back into play; or
- (c) has otherwise delayed play.

The field Umpire shall award a Free Kick to the Defending Team and a Fifty Metre Penalty from The Mark.



In recent weeks the RDFNL has struggled with finding good confident umpires following the affects of a missed season last year due to Covid 19.

It seems the issue with finding umpires is not just limited to our league though it is across the state.

So now more than ever it is so important to be looking after our umpires and treating them with the upmost respect while they act in an official role.

The RDFNL are lucky to have such a great umpires ambassador in James Matthews involved in the league.

James is one of 14 netball umpires across Australia named in the in the High-Performance Umpire Sauad.

He will feature among our grand final umpires but this week is he lending a word of advice to anyone looking to start umpiring.

Don't Blame the Umpire - James Matthews

To quote a Netball Scoop article in 2017,

"A standard game of netball is 60 minutes. The ball has to be passed at least every three seconds. This results in the ball being passed (at an absolute minimum) 1,200 times a match. Every time a player catches the ball, an umpire has to check seven things involving the player with the ball and their opponent (footwork, contact, how they got the ball, obstruction, offside etc.)." Sarah Black, Netball Scoop, 2017.

An umpire, in one 60 minute game, can make more than 22,800 decisions (and non-decisions) in a split second - Which is no mean feat. Whilst decisional accuracy is paramount in becoming a successful umpire, interpretation of rules and movement of players based on the foundational techniques of umpiring (Position, Vision & Timing) is something even the most seasoned umpire doesn't always get right.

The fundamental role of an umpire, in all sports, is to understand and apply the rules

in the essence in which they are intended to enhance the game for both player and spectator enjoyment. It takes a mentally tough and highly skilled individual to be able to umpire, it's not for everyone. For those that do try their hand at umpiring, the fulfillment and enjoyment of being able to positively contribute to the sport they are so passionate about is extremely rewarding. However, the flip side of the coin is that the nature of our game does attract equally passionate supporters and players and being able to navigate our way through how to be leaders and resilient whilst on court is pivotal in our success.

Having the structured approach of Rule 13, Game Management, a clearly defined code of conduct and knowing who to escalate concerns to allows the umpire to go about their business with the confidence that they can deal with any situation that may arise whilst on court. Building resilience is hard, however a pivotal component of our success as umpires, and having our rule knowledge and fully committing to immersing ourselves into the game we are umpiring (to the exclusion of all negative external factors) will hold us in good stead for this success. The old saying that the "Umpires are human too and make mistakes" is very true, but the standards are higher for those individuals given the pivotal role they play in the game which is also understandable.

The important thing to remember is, getting onto the court has been as a result of countless hours of work, dedication and commitment - so should be a celebrated achievement! The next time things don't go the way you hoped or you find yourself in a difficult situation, remember all the work you have done to get to this point to focus in on the task at hand. Mistakes are part of what we do sometimes, but learning from them is what makes us great umpires! If all else fails, ask yourself when was the last time people have had to make over 22,800 decisions and then - Don't blame the umpire.

Prediction: Macedon to return to the winners list.




